





Timeline for transition from North Catholic High School to CWNCHS:

June 2012 – Groundbreaking began on new, state-of-the-art CWNCHS campus in Cranberry Township.

Fall 2013 – Students will continue to attend the original campus in Troy Hill, but the curriculum will change to a new program of studies as part of CWNCHS.

Fall 2014 – Students will move to the new, state-of-the-art CWNCHS campus in Cranberry Township.

Teaching Philosophy

CWNCHS provides a caring and intellectually stimulating environment that embraces the students' unique talents. Following Marianist principles, each student is expected to give their fullest ability, both academically and personally.

Modern Facility and Academic Program

With a visionary focus on college preparation, the new 71-acre CWNCHS campus will feature 21st century facilities, laboratories and equipment.

- Local partners include Westinghouse Electric, Carnegie Mellon University, University of Pittsburgh, Duquesne University, La Roche College, Carlow University, UPMC, Highmark, and other medical facilities.
- Partnered with Chaminade Julianne High School, Dayton, Ohio as the **ONLY** Catholic High School in the United States with a Project Lead the Way Certified STEMM Program linked to Duke University, University of Illinois, Rochester Institute of Technology, University of Dayton and others.
- Professional staff, with continuing professional development provided by local universities, organizations and professionals in the Pittsburgh area, and in cooperation with the Chevron STEM Center at Carnegie Science Center.
- Each student will prepare an electronic portfolio

Residential Accommodations

CWNCHS participates in the *Holy Family International College Preparatory Program*, which offers a full boarding program in a quiet residential neighborhood with safe transportation to and from the school. In addition, students in the HFICPP will take advantage of the exceptional after-

school ELS and college guidance support offered to all international students.

Extra-Curricular Activities and Sports

CWNCHS has a strong “no-cut” policy, enabling universal participation in clubs such as debate, drama, campus ministry, National Honor Society, and Leadership Team. The policy applies to the sports teams as well, including basketball, cheerleading, crew, football, forensics, golf, soccer, softball, swimming, volleyball and wrestling.
